CONSECRATION TO JESUS CHRIST THROUGH MARY

On Monday, May 6, 2024, we invited you to start the Consecration to Jesus through Mary as we begin as one parish of The Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This process will last for 33 days. On June 8, we will make our personal Act of Consecration along with celebrating the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. You are free to use your own personal materials for this consecration. We are providing the book, *Preparation for Total Consecration To Jesus Christ Through Mary*, if you wish to participate and do not have your own materials. The book and PDF copy are available to parishioners in the Narthex. May this faith-filled, 33-day period help us to surrender into the life of Jesus Christ and become filled with spirit of Christ. TRANSITION TEAM UPDATE - IMPORTANT DATES

The **St. Mary and St. John XXIII Transition Team** (TT) met on **May 8** as we continue to progress toward one campus. At the meeting, the team recommended unanimously, identifying the property at St. John XXIII, as the one campus. Then a timeline was carefully laid out for the merger. Reminders will be posted in the bulletins as we approach each of these dates.

September 8, 2024: All activities besides Sunday Mass, will happen at the one campus of St. John XXIII Church. This includes daily Masses, meetings, gatherings, and any other activities. Funerals, weddings, and other special Masses may still occur.

Saturday, 4:00 p.m. and Sunday, 8:00 a.m. Mass will be at St. Mary until the final Mass on December 8. **December 8, 2024:** Final Mass held at St. Mary, Groveport. (The Sunday Mass schedule at St. Mary will remain the same up to this date.)

December 9, 2024: ALL activities, including Sunday Masses, will be held at St. John XXIII Church. The next step is to begin the *relegation process. St. Mary Church will no longer be used for parish purposes. *When a church is no longer used for divine worship, the diocesan bishop may relegate it for profane (normal), but not sordid use (Can. 1222 §1).

THE APPEAL 2024

The Appeal 2024 has officially launched. You should have received a letter from the Bishop, as well as from Father O'Connor. If you have NOT received a letter from Fr. O'Connor, please see Heather in the Parish Office. We work hard to have accurate contact info for our parish. Please stop by the office to provide your mailing address, so that you are included as a parishioner here. Not only for future mailings, but for census purposes, as well. There are Appeal 2024 envelopes in the Narthex if you would like to make your pledge and payment. Last year, both parishes were successful in reaching the set goal for each location. For 2023, SJXXIII Parish surpassed their goal by more than ten thousand dollars and St. Mary met their goal for the first time in many years. Thank you to all who contributed to this last year; let's do it again this year! St. Mary's parish goal is \$27,005.40. St. John XXIII parish goal is \$47,742.95 for The Appeal 2024. In the coming months, St. Mary, Groveport, and St. John XXIII will become one vibrant, unified parish. With this merger, we face a unique situation regarding our financial goals for The Appeal. Canonically, the merging of financial interests among parishes is not permitted before the official merger. While combining parish goal amounts may seem easier at the beginning of the campaign, it is not recommended. Once the merger of our parishes is completed, we will come together and have one combined Appeal goal of \$74,748.35. We believe we can surpass the combined total of \$74,748.35. As in years past, anything over the goal we collect will be returned to the parish to use for parish needs. Let's make The Appeal 2024 another year of success!

HELP WANTED:



The Ohio EdChoice Expansion Scholarship program now offers ALL Ohio students the opportunity for a scholarship to attend a Catholic school! With the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship, a family of four making \$140,400.00 per year or less is eligible for a full scholarship for each child in the amount of \$6,166.00 (K-8)



PLENARY INDULGENCES

The Dominican Order is currently celebrating a Triple Jubilee in honor of St. Thomas Aquinas, remembering the 700th Anniversary of his canonization (which was celebrated in July 2023), the 750th Anniversary of his death (which was celebrated on March 7, 2024), and the 800th Anniversary of his birth (which will be celebrated in 2025). In honor of these anniversaries, the Apostolic Penitentiary grants a Plenary Indulgence to those who make a pilgrimage to a holy place connected with the Dominican Order, and there devoutly take part in the jubilee ceremonies, or at least devote a suitable time to pious recollection, concluding with the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and invocations of the Blessed Virgin Mary and of Saint Thomas Aquinas. Any church, shrine, or chapel currently entrusted to the Dominican Order can meet the requirements for the pilgrimage. In the Diocese of Columbus, St. Patrick Church in Columbus, St. Joseph Church in Somerset, and Holy Trinity Church in Somerset are entrusted to the Dominican Friars. The Plenary Indulgence may be obtained until January 28, 2025 under the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession 20 days before or after the indulgenced act, reception of Holy Communion, prayers for the Intentions of the Holy Father, and complete detachment from sin, including venial sin.
